BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Redmond as follows:-

Section 1. That Kirkland Street from the West line of Lot 7 in Block 5 of Sikes' First Addition to Redmond, to Union Street; and Union Street from Kirland Street to Jackson Street be and the same are hereby ordered improved by grading the same, providing for the necessary surface drainage by gravelling the roadways and doing such other work as may be necessary in connection therewith, the same to be known as Local Improvement District No.

Section 3. That the entire cost of the improvement provided for herein shall be paid by special assessment upon the property specially benefited in the manner provided by law and that no part thereof shall be paid from the general fund of the town of Redmond.
