RESOLUTION NO. 383

A RESOLUTION approving a Petition for Inclusion of Additional Territory Within the King County Conservation District and authorizing signing the same.

WHEREAS, the King County Conservation District was duly organized as a governmental subdivision of the State pursuant to Chapter 184, Laws of 1973; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it will be in the best interest and for the benefit and welfare of the citizens of the City of Redmond and is necessary in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare that the incorporated limits of the City of Redmond be included within the territory of the King County Conservation District; Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Approval of Petition. That it is in the best interest in the City of Redmond that the incorporated limits of the City be included within the King County Conservation District and that the attached Petition for Inclusion of Additional Territory be approved.


2. Signing of Petition authorized. That the Mayor, City Clerk and Council members be authorized and empowered to sign the Petition for Inclusion of Additional Territory Within the King County Conservation District on behalf of the City of Redmond.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 18 day of November, 1975.



PETITION FOR INCLUSION OF ADDITIONAL TERRITORY

TO: The State Conservation Commission
