A RESOLUTION of Christmas cheer and goodwill.

Christmas time provides an opportunity for <u>all</u> people of whatever faith, creed or belief, to pause for a moment and search for the real meaning, the inner meaning for each of us, of the substance of life itself;

Christmas time is a time for quiet reflection away from the usual demands of life's pursuits, to sort out the important from that which in reality is trivial, and to find that moment of peace which can only come from our own understanding of ourselves and our relationship to others;

Christmas is also a time for joyous celebration, mindful of sorrow and suffering, but with a true understanding that happiness exists within each of us and is eternally there to provide satisfaction, comfort and delight, whether we be alone or in a moment of social intercourse with each other;
