RESOLUTION NO. 416

A RESOLUTION, approving a Memorandum of Understanding of agreement for 1977 between the City and the Newspaper and Magazine Drivers and Chauffeurs, Local Union No. 763, representing certain non-uniformed employees of the City; and authorizing the Mayor to execute the same on behalf of the City of Redmond.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond by its Resolution No. 274, passed September 21, 1971, recognized the Newspaper and Magazine Drivers and Chauffeurs, Local Union No. 763, hereafter referred to as the Union, as the exclusive bargaining representative of the employees therein included; and

WHEREAS, the parties have heretofore approved and signed a revised collective bargaining agreement to be in effect between January 1, 1976, through December 31, 1977, subject to further negotiations and amendment with respect to salaries and wages only for the calendar year 1977; and

WHEREAS, representatives of the City and the Union have met and agreed upon a Memorandum of Understanding agreement with respect to a revision in salaries and wages for 1977 and the City Council has determined that the same should be approved and executed by the City, Now, Therefore,


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Memorandum of Understanding agreement approved. That certain Memorandum of Understanding agreement between the City of Redmond and the Union, covering certain employees of the City of Redmond effective January 1, 1977, through December 31, 1977, a copy of which is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, is hereby approved.

2. Mayor and City Clerk authorized to execute agreement. The Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to and empowered to execute such agreement on behalf of the City of Redmond.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 15<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1977.
