RESOLUTION NO. 417

A RESOLUTION, relating to land use and planning; creating a Development Guide Advisory Commission; and providing for the appointment of citizen committees in connection with the preparation of the Redmond Development Guide.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Creation of the Development Guide Advisory Commission. To assist in the formulation and review of the Redmond Community Development Guide (Development Guide), a Development Guide Advisory Commission (DGAC) is hereby created. The DGAC shall consist of the members and commissioners of the Park Board and the Planning Commission. Members of the DGAC shall serve only as long as they remain members of the Park Board and Planning Commission, and new appointees of the Park Board and Planning Commission shall automatically become members of the DGAC.

Section 2. Purpose of the DGAC. The purpose and function of the DGAC will be to formulate and review the revisions and reorganization of Redmond's plans, policies and regulations relating to land use and land development into the Development Guide and to utilize substantial public involvement in the process.

Section 3. Authority and Duties. The DGAC has the authority to draft, review, discuss, hold work sessions and hearings, commence studies, and make recommendations to the City Council on the Development Guide or its parts as it deems necessary. The DGAC shall establish and appoint members to its committees as set forth in Section 4 of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Appointment of committees. In order to maximize the involvement of the general public in the preparation of the Development Guide, the DGAC shall establish three or more committees each consisting of approximately seven (7) citizens and at least two DGAC members. The appointment of the citizen members shall be based on the following criteria: a wide representation of interests, geographic location, range of knowledge and skills, an expressed desire to serve, broad age distribution, and status as a resident, property owner, or businessman with the Redmond Planning Study Area.


Section 5. Organization and work of the DGAC. Upon their appointment, the DGAC shall organize and shall elect a chairman and vice chairman and other officers as may be appropriate and may determine rules and procedures for their meetings, hearings, and committees. Each committee shall elect a chairman and vice chairman from among the citizen appointees.

Section 6. Staff support. Staff support of the DGAC shall be given by the Planning and Park Departments and other departments as the need arises or subject matter warrants.

Section 7. Termination of the DGAC. The DGAC and its committees shall terminate on July 31, 1977, or upon the adoption of the Development Guide by the City Council, whichever occurs first.


