ORDINANCE NO. 43.

An Ordinance Relating to the Licensing and Regulating of Hawkers and Peddlers, providing Penalties for the Violation thereof, and Repealing all Ordinances Inconsistent therewith.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Redmond as follows: SECTION I. - LICENSES

It shall be unlawful for any person to hawk or peddle any goods, wares or merchandise within the limits of the Town of Redmond without first obtaining a license as a peddler or hawker as provided in this Ordinance, and first paying therefor into the Town Treasury the prescribed license fee; provided that no person shall be required to take out a license or pay a fee for the peddling of newspapers, magazines or other periodicals; and provided further, that no license shall be required of any person to peddle fruits, vegetables, berries, butter, eggs, fish, milk, poultry, meats, or any farm produce or edibles raised, caught, produced or manufactured by such person in any place in this state.

SECTION II. - PEDDLER DEFINED.

The term peddler for the purpose of this Ordinance shall be construed to include all persons, both principals and agents, who go from place to place, or house to house, carrying for sale, exposing for sale, or offering for sale, goods, wares and merchandise.

SECTION III - APPLICATION AND LICENSE FEE.

Every peddler or hawker, whether principal or agent, shall, before commencing business in the Town of Redmond, make application in writing and under oath to the Town Treasurer for a license and shall pay the Treasurer a license fee of One Hundfed (100) Dollars per annum.

SECTION IV - PENALTY.

Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeaner, and upon conviction shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days or by a fine of not more than One Hundred (100) Dollars, or by both.

SECTION V - REPEALING CLAUSE.

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION VI - EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
