RESOLUTION NO. 4/34

A RESOLUTION, relating to block grant funds for community development programs and projects under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-383) for 1977-79; and amending the estimated costs for Priority A (1977) Programs.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond, pursuant to public hearings held on November 2, 1976, and November 16, 1976, prioritized certain Community Development programs and projects for 1977-79 under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (PL 93-383) and adopted Resolution 410 on December 7, 1976, setting forth such programs and projects together ith the estimated cost thereof; and

WHEREAS, there arises certain differences in the costs projected for programs and projects set forth for calendar year 1977, necessitating the revision of Resolution 410 to establish new estimated costs for certain items which will not affect the priorities and projects therein established for Block Grant Community Development Programs; Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment. The estimated costs of Priority A (1977) Programs set forth in Paragraph 1 of Resolution No. 410, passed December 7, 1976, are amended as follows:

PRIORITY A (1977)
Housing and Community Development Program

Program

(1) Community Center and Transportation

(2) Walkway Construction

Project

Phase II improvements to community center at Anderson Park and continued operation of passenger van.

ESTIMATED COST: \$6,500

- (A) Five foot walkways on N.E. 80th Street from 132nd Avenue N.E. to 140th Avenue N.E.
- (B) Four foot walkways on 171st Avenue N.E. from N.E. 80th Street to N.E. 95th Street
- (C) Complete walkway along Redmond Way in vicinity of Cascade Vista Retirement Center.

ESTIMATED COST: \$70,105

Priority A (1977) items (4) through (8) inclusive, Priority B (1978) and Priority C (1979) items contained in said Paragraph 1 of Resolution No. 410 shall remain the same.

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
