RESOLUTION NO. 445

A RESOLUTION, adopting and approving certain joint community development program and project for block grant funds under the Housing and Community Development Act, 1974, Public Laws 93-383-380; approving project application for the calendar year 1978.

WHEREAS, King County is an urban county applicant for block grant funds under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, Pub. L. 93-383, and an Urban County Consortium has been established by interlocal cooperation agreements between the County and certain local municipal corporations within the County to which the City of Redmond is a party; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of said interlocal cooperation agreements and to qualify for reimbursement of eligible block grant community development programs under the Act, the City Council duly held a public hearing on August 16, 1977, and following such public hearing, has established priorities for community development block grant programs and projects within the City of Redmond and has approved the submission of appropriate applications therefor.

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes the need to provide increased services within the City of Redmond and surrounding area for youth under the age of eighteen, and that Youth Eastside Services/Lake Washington School Juvenile Service Project will provide many of the services and programs for the youth in this area, Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Joint program approved. That under that certain document entitled "Housing and Community Development Plan 1978-80, City of Redmond, August, 1977," which has heretofore been approved by Resolution No. 444, adopted on September 6, 1977, as the Cities Block Grant Community Development Program and priorities for 1978-80, that certain joint project known as Youth Eastside Services/Lake Washington School Juvenile Services project, is hereby specifically approved as a joint and cooperative effort with King County and other entities.

Section 2. Application approved. The submission of appropriate applications and agreements for Block Grant funding of the Community Development Program and project for the City of Redmond, as set forth above in paragraph 1 of this Resolution, is hereby approved.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 20 day of September, 1977.


