RESOLUTION NO. 474

A RESOLUTION, adopting and approving certain joint community development program and project for block grant funds under the Housing and Community Development Act, 1974, Public Laws 93-383-380; approving joint project application for the fiscal year 1979.

WHEREAS, King County is an urban county applicant for block grant funds under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, by interlocal cooperation agreements between the County and certain local municipal corporations within the County to which the City of Redmond is a party; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of said interlocal cooperation agreements and to qualify for reimbursement of eligible block grant community development programs under the Act, the City Council duly held a public hearing on August 15, 1978, and following such public hearing, has established priorities for community development block grant programs and projects within the City of Redmond and has approved the submission of appropriate applications therefor;

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes the need to provide increased services within the City of Redmond and surrounding area for youth under the age of fourteen, and that Youth Eastside Services/Lake Washington School Juvenile Service Project will provide many of the services and programs for the youth in this area; and

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes the need to provide increased mental health counseling services to citizens within the City of Redmond and surrounding area, and that Eastside Community Mental Center will provide many mental health services in this area; Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Joint Programs approved. That pursuant to and to implement that certain document entitled "Three-Year Community Development Plan 1979-81, City of Redmond, August 1978," which has heretofore been approved by the Council on August 15, 1978, as the City's Block Grant Community Development Program and priorities for 1979-81, that certain joint projects known as Youth Eastside Services/Lake Washington School Juvenile Services project and Eastside Community Mental Health Center project, are hereby specifically approved as a joint and cooperative effort with King County and other entities.

Section 2. Application approved. The submission of appropriate applications and agreements for Block Grant funding of the Community Development Program and projects for the City of Redmond as set forth above in paragraph 1 of this Resolution, is hereby approved.
