RESOLUTION NO. 494

A RESOLUTION fixing the date, time and place for a public hearing to be held before the City Council upon a Petition for the Vacation of N.E. 84th Street (Portion of Redmond Center, Lots 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16).

WHEREAS, a written Petition for Vacation of Right-of-Way, signed by two-thirds or more of the abutting property owners, has been filed with the City and presented to the City Council on March 20, 1979, requesting that the City Council vacate that certain right-of-way lying within the limits of the City of Redmond, King County, Washington, described as follows:

All of North East 84th Street lying between the extended East margin of 158th Avenue N.E., and the extended West margin of 160th Avenue N.E. all according to the Plat of Redmond Center according to the plat thereof recorded in volume 59, pages 94, 95, 96, and 97 of Plats, records of King County, Washington.

as depicted on the sketch or map on the attached Exhibit "A", Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Date set for public hearing. That the date of May 1, 1979, at the hour of 8:00 p.m., is hereby fixed as the date and time for a public hearing on said Petition for Vacation or Right-of-Way to be held at the City Hall before the City Council.

Section 2. Notice. That the City Clerk is directed to cause due and proper notice of such hearing to be given in the form and manner required by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 20th day of March, 1979.

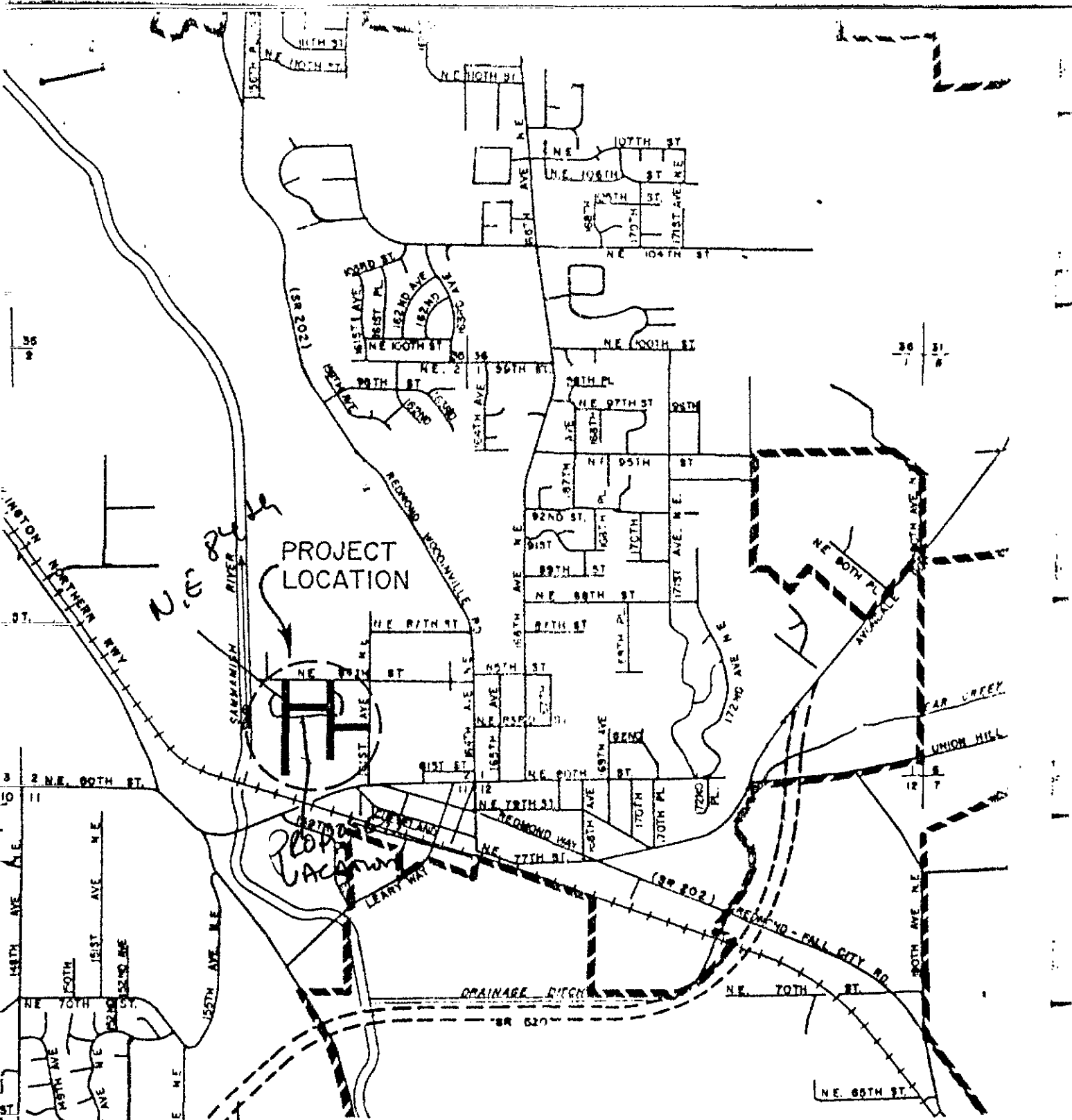
