RESOLUTION NO. 501

A RESOLUTION fixing the date, time and place for a public hearing to be held before the City Council upon a Petition for the Vacation of an alley in Sikes 3rd Addition.

WHEREAS, a written Petition for Vacation of Right-of-Way, signed by two-thirds or more of the abutting property owners, has been filed with the City and presented to the City Council on June 19, 1979, requesting that the City Council vacate that certain right-of-way lying within the limits of the City of Redmond, King County, Washington, described as follows:

A 16 foot wide alley platted in block 1 Sikes 3rd Addition to the City of Redmond, according to plat recorded in Volume 9 of plats, page 68, in King County Washington.

Now, Therefore,


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Date set for public hearing. That the date of July 17, 1979, at the hour of 8:00 p.m., is hereby fixed as the date and time for a public hearing on said Petition for Vacation of Right-of-Way to be held at the City Hall before the City Council.

Section 2. Notice. That the City Clerk is directed to cause due and proper notice of such hearing to be given in the form and manner required by law.
