Eastside Community Mental Health Center/Elderly Outreach Program Block Grant Joint Application

RESOLUTION NO. 507

A RESOLUTION to support the Block Grant Joint Application submitted to King County by Eastside Community Mental Health Center for an elderly outreach program.

WHEREAS, King County is an urban county applicant for block grant funds under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, P.L. 93-383, and an Urban County Consortium has been established by interlocal municipal corporations within the County to which the City of Redmond is a party; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond has adopted a Three-Year Community Development Plan establishing goals and strategies for projects funded by the Block Grant Program which will improve the delivery of youth and mental health counseling services and has worked closely with Eastside Community Mental Health Center to provide such services through block grant funds and other community support; Now, Therefore,


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. City support of elderly outreach program. The City of Redmond agrees to support and participate with Eastside Community Mental Health Center as a joint sponsor of the elderly outreach program.

Section 2. Notification of King County. The King County Department of Housing and Community Development shall be notified that the City of Redmond will support and sponsor the project jointly with Eastside Community Mental Health Center.


