RESOLUTION NO. 515

A RESOLUTION amending community development programs and projects for block grant funds under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, P.L. 93-383 and reallocating unused funds from program years 1977-1978.

WHEREAS, King County is an urban county applicant for block grant funds under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, Publ. L. 93-383, and an Urban County Consortium has been established by interlocal cooperation agreements between the County and certain local municipal corporations within the County to which the City of Redmond is a party; and

WHEREAS, under such program for the program years 1977-78, the City of Redmond did establish priorities, approved certain projects for submission and did submit applications therefor which were approved, and there now exists unused funds the total amount of \$47,094.00 which need to be reallocated to eligible projects and programs, Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Reallocation of Block Grant Community Development Program Funds for 1977-78. Unused funds from the 1977-78 block grant program will be reallocated to the following existing and new projects in order of priority:

- 1. Senior Transportation (CD-544-78) \$ 508.00
- 2. Fullard House Renovation (CD-929-79) 4,000.00
- 3. Custom Industries: Building construction 29,750.00
- 4. Coordinated Human Services Program 7,000.00
- 5. Housing Repair Program (CD-739-79) 5,836.00
Program will be expanded to include energy conservation and lien loan program.

\$47,094.00

Section 2. Applications Approved. The submission of appropriate applications and agreements for block grant funding of the community development programs and projects for the City of Redmond adopted in Paragraph 1 of this Resolution, is hereby approved.
