

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 516

A RESOLUTION, providing for the construction of sidewalks upon N.E. 99th Street from its intersection with 166th Avenue N.E., to 150 feet west of 164th Avenue N.E.; providing that all of the costs thereof shall be borne by the abutting property owners; and setting the date for a public hearing.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that N.E. 99th Street from its intersection with 166th Avenue N.E. to 150 feet west of 164th Avenue N.E. should be improved by the construction of sidewalks pursuant to the authority granted by RCW Chapter 35.68 and that the cost thereof should be borne entirely by the abutting property owners and that a public hearing should be held to consider such improvements, Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Description and extent of improvements. Pursuant to RCW Chapter 35.68, the City Council does hereby declare that sidewalks hereafter referred to as the improvement, shall be constructed on both sides upon N.E. 99th Street, from its intersection with 166th Avenue N.E. to 150 feet west of 164th Avenue N.E. The improvement shall be constructed in accordance with City of Redmond standards and specifications and shall be paid for entirely by the abutting property owners by means of an assessment roll determined by assessing each abutting lot an equal amount.


2. Plans and specifications -- estimated cost. Director of Public Works shall cause plans and specifications to be prepared for the improvement, the estimated cost for which is \$24,000; and shall determine the preliminary assessment to be levied against each abutting property owner.

3. Hearing date. The date, time, place and authority for a hearing to be held to consider all matters in connection with the improvement is hereby set and established for January 15, 1980, at 8:00 P.M., at the Redmond City Hall, Redmond, Washington, before the City Council.


4. Notice of hearing. The Director of Public Works shall cause this resolution to be published for two consecutive weeks before the time of hearing in the official newspaper of the City and shall cause notice of the date of such hearing to be given to each owner or reputed owner of the abutting property by mailing to the owner or reputed owner of the property as shown on the tax rolls of the County Treasurer, at the address shown thereon, a notice of the date of hearing, such mailing to be at least ten (10) days before the date fixed for the hearing.


