RESOLUTION NO. 519

A RESOLUTION, relating to the vacation of a portion of N.E. 110th Street at its intersection with 162nd Avenue N.E.; and amending Section 2 of Resolution No. 511 to set a new date, time and place for a public hearing thereon.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment. Section 2 of Resolution No. 511, passed November 20, 1979, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. Public Hearing Set - Notice. That the date of February 19, 1980, at 8:00 P.M., at the City Hall, Redmond, Washington, before the City Council is hereby set as the date, time, place and authority for a public hearing to be held to consider the question of the vacation of such street and public way; and the City Clerk shall give due and proper notice of such hearing in the manner required by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 2nd day of January, 1980.


