

ORDINANCE NO. 52

AN ORDINANCE relating to the rules and regulations governing the use of city water of the Town of Redmond by any one within or without the town limits, and amending Ordinance No. 35 and all other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND, as follows:


Section I. That Section XIV of Ordinance No. 35 of the Town of Redmond be amended to read as follows:

Meter rates shall be as follows: For the first 500 cubic feet or less, per month \$1.50. For each 100 cubic feet used over 500 cubic feet up to and including 3000 cubic feet,  $7\frac{1}{2}\phi$ . For each 100 cubic feet used over 3000 cubic feet,  $5\phi$ .

All water rates and charges shall be payable on or before the tenth of each month. If payment is not made by the fifteenth of each month, water will be shut off and not turned on again until all arrears and a fee of fifty cents <sup>per</sup> ~~our~~ paid.

The method of computing rates shall be to the nearest 100 cubic feet.
