

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 521

A RESOLUTION, approving a joint application with the City of Bellevue for an Urban Design Grant through the National Endowment for the Arts; and authorizing the Mayor to sign on behalf of the City of Redmond.

WHEREAS, the cities of Redmond and Bellevue would each receive considerable benefit from a study designed to develop urban design policies and guidelines; Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Preparation of Application Approved. The Department of Planning and Community Development is authorized and directed to work with its counterparts in the City of Bellevue to prepare and submit a joint application to the National Endowment for the Arts for an Urban Design Grant to enable the two cities to conduct a study and develop urban design policies and guidelines to assist in urban planning and development.

2. Mayor Authorized to Sign. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign and execute such a joint application on behalf of the City of Redmond
