RESOLUTION NO. 532

CITY OF REDMOND

A RESOLUTION SETTING A DATE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON A PETITION FOR VACATION OF A PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a petition for vacation of a ten foot wide walkway extending eastward from 143rd Avenue N.E. between lots 54 and 55 of the Bellewood East #9 subdivision (commonly known as Bellewood North) containing the signatures of the owners of more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon said right-of-way sought to be vacated has been filed with the City Clerk, and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk has determined that said petition is sufficient in form, now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Redmond, Washington that a public hearing upon said petition shall be held in the Council chambers of the Redmond City Hall at 8:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, on June 17, 1980, which is not less than 28 nor more than 60 days from the date of passage of this resolution, at which hearing all persons interested in said right-of-way vacation are invited to appear. The City Clerk is directed to post notices of said hearing in three public places and on the right-of-way to be vacated at least 20 days prior to the date set for hearing, pursuant to RCW 35.79.
