RESOLUTION NO. 533

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, SETTING THE DATE, TIME, PLACE AND AUTHORITY FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE FINAL ASSESSMENT ROLLS FOR LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 79-ST-32.

WHEREAS, the assessment roll for local improvements in connection with LID 79-ST-32 (N.E. 99th Street improvements) has been prepared as provided by law and has been filed with the City Clerk, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Public hearing set. That the date, time, place and authority for a public hearing to be held to consider recommendations, objections and other comments in connection with fixing the final assessment roll for Local Improvement District No. 79-ST-32 is hereby set and established for July 1, 1980, at 8:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, at the Redmond City Hall, Redmond, Washington, before the City Council.

Section 2. Notice. The City Clerk shall cause appropriate notices to be published and mailed to the property owner affected in the manner provided by law.
