RESOLUTION NO. 535

CITY OF REDMOND

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 532 PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON MAY 6, 1980, TO ESTABLISH A NEW DATE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON A PETITION FOR VACATION OF A PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS COMMONLY KNOWN AS A PORTION OF BELLEWOOD NORTH.

WHEREAS, a petition for vacation of a ten foot wide walkway extending eastward from 143rd Avenue Northeast between lots 54 and 55 of the Bellewood East #9 subdivision (commonly known as Bellewood North) containing the signatures of the owners of more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon said right-of-way sought to be vacated has been filed with the City Clerk, and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk has determined that said petition is sufficient in form, and

WHEREAS, the City Council had by resolution no. 532, passed May 6, 1980, set June 17, 1980 as the date for a public hearing on the matter, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to change the date of said public hearing, now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Redmond, Washington that a public hearing upon said petition shall be held in the Council chambers of the Redmond City Hall at 8:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, on July 1, 1980, which is not less than 28 nor more than 60 days from the date of passage of this resolution, at which hearing all persons interested in said right-of-way vacation are invited to appear. The City Clerk is directed to post, publish and mail notices of said hearing at least 28 days prior to the date set for hearing, pursuant to Redmond Municipal Code Section 20F.20.070(15)(b)
