

ORDINANCE NO. 54

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO AND PROVIDING FOR THE INSPECTION OF ALL PREMISES AND PROPERTY IN THE TOWN OF REDMOND TO ASCERTAIN THE PRESENCE OF EARWIGS; PROVIDING FOR MEANS AND METHODS TO EXTERMINATE THE SAME; AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS TOWARD DEFRAYING THE EXPENSE THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Redmond as follows:

SECTION I. That the Bureau of Earwig Control, composed of representatives of the State Department of Agriculture, the County of King, and the Health Department of the City of Seattle, its agents and employees, is hereby authorized and empowered to go into and be upon all property and premises in the Town of Redmond at all reasonable times during the year 1928 for the purpose of inspecting said premises to ascertain the presence of earwigs.

SECTION II. That the said Bureau of Earwig Control, its agents and employees, is hereby authorized and empowered to place and maintain earwig bait upon any premises or property in the Town of Redmond which, in its opinion, requires baiting for the purpose of exterminating or preventing the spread or propagation of earwigs.

SECTION III. That the expense of any such inspection or baiting done under the authority of this Ordinance shall be borne and provided for solely by the said Bureau of Earwig Control and shall not be charged against or paid by the Town of Redmond; save and except that the Town of Redmond does hereby appropriate and contribute the sum of One Hundred (100) Dollars. Said sum, or as much thereof as shall in the opinion of said Bureau be necessary, shall be paid by the Treasurer of the Town of Redmond to said Bureau of Earwig Control as the portion of the expense to be borne by the Town of Redmond.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after the date of its passage, signature, attestation and publication in the manner required by law.
