RESOLUTION NO. 558

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, ACKNOWLEDGING THAT THE REDMOND DERBY DAYS FESTIVAL IS A DESIRABLE AND BENEFICIAL COMMUNITY ACTIVITY AND COMMENDING ALL THOSE WHOSE EFFORTS CONTRIBUTED TO ITS SUCCESS.

WHEREAS, "Derby Days" has been a traditional annual event in the Redmond Community for many years and is the sole community celebration wholly conceived and developed by the citizens of the City of Redmond, and

WHEREAS, the Redmond Derby Days Festival held on July 27th and 28th of 1980, was a thoroughly successful community enterprise of the sort which should be encouraged and supported by the City, and

WHEREAS, the time and effort contributed by many of Redmond's citizens was essential to the success of the festival and is deserving of recognition, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Redmond hereby formally acknowledges that the Redmond Derby Days Festival is a valuable community event which stems from a long tradition of annual celebration originated and perpetuated by the citizens of the Redmond community. The City of Redmond hereby expresses its encouragement of and support for continued success of "Derby Days".

Section 2. The City of Redmond commends all those whose efforts combined to make the 1980 Redmond Derby Days Festival a success, including Tom Paur, "Derby Days" chairman, members of the Redmond Chamber of Commerce, the police explorers, and City employees in the police, park, public works and fire departments.
