

RESOLUTION NO. 565

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING A DATE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING UPON THE PROPOSED VACATION OF A PORTION OF NORTHEAST 32ND STREET, A PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, the City has received a proposal from the owner of property adjacent to that portion of Northeast 32nd Street extending eastward from 172nd Avenue N.E. to the westerly boundary of that portion of Northeast 32nd Street previously vacated pursuant to Redmond City Ordinance No. 873, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a public hearing should be held for the purpose of considering said proposal, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, that a public hearing upon the proposed vacation of a portion of Northeast 32nd Street extending easterly from 172nd Avenue N.E. to the westerly boundary of that portion of Northeast 32nd Street previously vacated pursuant to Redmond City Ordinance No. 873 should be held in the City Council chambers of the Redmond City Hall at 8:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, on January 6, 1981, which is not less than 28 nor more than 60 days from the date of passage of this resolution, at which hearing all persons interested in said right-of-way vacation are invited to appear and be heard. The City Clerk is directed to post, publish and mail notices of said hearing at least 28 days prior to the date set for hearing, pursuant to Redmond Municipal Code Section 20F.20.070(15)(b).
