

RESOLUTION NO. 575

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR HUD COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT TO ASSESS DISTRICT HEATING/COOLING SYSTEMS POTENTIAL.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development is soliciting applications for cooperative agreements to (a) assess the feasibility of district heating/cooling systems in communities; (b) assists communities in developing consensus of whether or not to proceed with such a system; and (c) if it is decided to proceed, aid the community in implementing the project, and

WHEREAS, the project is intended to support the objectives of the national and local community development block grant program by reducing heating costs for citizens assisting economic development and commercial revitalization, and improving air quality, and

WHEREAS, the intent of the HUD request is to assure the involvement of public and private parties in the community to assess the feasibility of district heating/cooling and, where appropriate, to implement a district heating/cooling system, and

WHEREAS, important criteria for award to an applicant includes the community's capability and commitment, the breadth and depth of the community involvement, and the opportunities for district heating/cooling systems, and

WHEREAS, Trans Energy Systems, Inc., a subsidiary of ROCKCOR, Inc., is experienced in all elements of the proposed feasibility study, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for the HUD Cooperative Agreement No. 6500 to Assess

District Heating/Cooling Systems Potential in Community Development-Block Grant Eligible Communities, dated November 17, 1980.

Section 2. The Mayor and staff are further authorized to assemble representatives of private and public institutions and individuals who may be affected by the district heating/cooling system project to serve on the assessment work group for the purpose of accomplishing the objectives of the cooperative agreement.

Section 3. The Mayor is further authorized to retain Trans Energy Systems, Inc., a subsidiary of ROCKCOR, Inc., as lead engineering consultant and team member of the assessment work group for the feasibility study if funding is received.
