

RESOLUTION NO. 583

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, APPROVING REVISIONS TO THE 1980 HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM TO CONSOLIDATE AND REALLOCATE UNUSED FUNDS AND AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 514.

WHEREAS, The City Council passed Resolution No. 514 on November 20, 1979, establishing the City's 1980 Block Grant Programs, and

WHEREAS, there is a need to revise those programs for the purpose of consolidating funds and reallocating unused funds, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Resolution No. 514 passed on November 20, 1979, is hereby amended to reflect the following consolidations and reallocations of funds:

1. Senior Citizen Transportation:

- (a) Operation and maintenance of existing van for senior activities in the Park Department \$ 2,500.00
- (b) Purchase of new van equipped for handicapped, and salary for driver to expand services to the Senior Citizens Club \$20,625.00

2. Home Improvements:

Home improvements including consolidation of major and minor home repair, home security, sewer connections and LID assistance and smoke detector program \$46,400.00

3. Coordinated Human Services Program:

1/2 time professional staff member to work with seniors, handicapped, youth and low-income families to coordinate social service programs. \$ 9,600.00

4. LW/YES - Youth Advocacy Project:

Professional services for low-income youths and families. \$19,800.00

Section 2. The City Clerk is directed to forward a certified copy of this resolution to King County.
