

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 586

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, EXPRESSING THE CITY'S INTENTION TO ANNEX CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY, COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE FIR TREE ANNEXATION, CITY FILE NO. A-81-2, PURSUANT TO RCW 35A.14.295

WHEREAS, there is within the City certain unincorporated territory, commonly known as the Fir Tree Annexation, City File No. A-81-2, more particularly described hereinafter, containing less than 100 acres of land and having at least 80% of the boundaries of such area contiguous to the City, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that such territory should be annexed to the City, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Intent to Annex Unincorporated Island.

That certain territory commonly known as the Fir Tree Annexation, City File No. A-81-2, legally described as:

Fir Tree Addition, as per plat recorded in Volume 48 of Plats, on page 37, Records of King County, Washington, together with that portion of N.E. 51st Street as shown on the map of East Side Gardens, as per plat recorded in Volume 12 of said plats, on Page 68, adjoining said Fir Tree Addition on the north.

Except those portions thereof annexed by Redmond Ordinances Nos. 560 and 793,

the boundaries of which are depicted on the attached Exhibit "A", which is incorporated herein by this reference as if set forth in full, constitutes an unincorporated island of territory within the City and should be annexed to the City pursuant to RCW 35A.14.295.

Section 2. Number of Voters residing in Area to be Annexed. The number of voters residing in the area to be annexed as described above is zero (0), as nearly as may be determined from the records of the King County Department of Records and Elections.

Section 3. Public Hearing. A public hearing upon the proposed annexation will be held before the City Council on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1981, at 8:00 p.m., in the Chambers of the City Council at Redmond City Hall, 15670 N.E. 85th Street, Redmond, Washington, at which time all interested persons are invited to attend and be heard with regard to the proposed annexation.

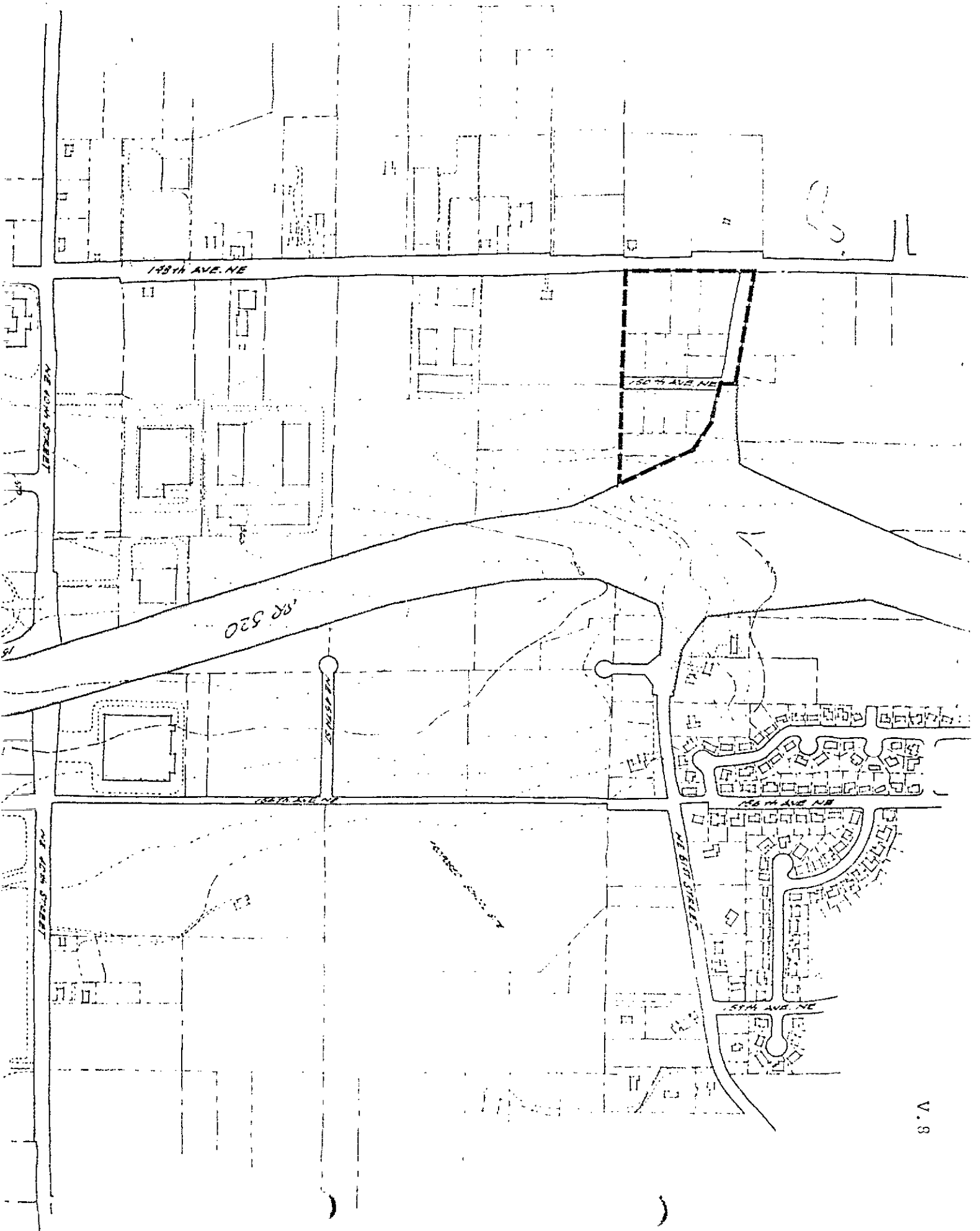
