RESOLUTION NO. 592

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, COMMENDING FRANK C. HANSCHKE, P.E., FOR EXEMPLARY SERVICES RENDERED TO THE CITY.


