

ORDINANCE NO. 6

An Ordinance providing for the Presentations of Demands  
and for the Issuance and payment of Warrants.

-----

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the town of Redmond as  
follows:-

(1) Demands. All demands against the town shall be presented by the claimant in writing at a regular meeting of the council. Said demands when so presented shall be by the mayor referred to the appropriate committee, said committee shall report at the same or at a later meeting upon the said demands and shall endorse upon the same their recommendation for the acceptance or rejection of the same, said recommendation to be signed by those members of the committee present at the meeting. When said demands have been recommended for allowance by the committee to which the same have been referred, same shall be allowed by the Council only upon vote of said council; but the same may be allowed by the Council even though rejected by the committee but no demand shall be allowed at any meeting except a regular meeting of the council nor by vote of any less than three members of the Council.

(2) Warrants. Upon any demand being allowed by vote of the council a warrant shall be drawn on the proper fund for the payment thereof, said warrant to be signed by the mayor and countersigned by the clerk. Warrants upon each fund shall be numbered consecutively in the order in which the same may be allowed.

(3) Payment of Warrants. Whenever a warrant shall be properly issued by the mayor and clerk the treasurer shall pay the same upon presentation, provided there be sufficient moneys in the fund upon which the same is drawn to pay said warrant and all earlier warrants of a smaller number, but no warrant shall be paid unless there shall be in the said fund sufficient moneys

for the payment of same and all earlier warrants. In the event there shall not be sufficient money in any fund to so pay any warrants then the treasurer shall stamp the same "Not paid for want of Funds" giving the date of presentation and thereafter said warrant shall draw interest at the rate of <sup>seven</sup>~~eight~~ per cent per annum.
