

RESOLUTION NO. 600

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR THE KING COUNTY SENIOR HOUSING PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, King County has proposed that a housing facility for senior citizens be established within the City of Redmond, as part of the King County Senior Housing Program, administered by the King County Housing and Community Development Division, and

WHEREAS, in order to seek funding for this program King County will be submitting an application for 1982 block grant funding, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is appropriate that the City express its support of the King County Senior Housing Program, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, hereby expresses its support for the King County Senior Housing Program and in particular the proposal to construct a senior citizen housing facility within the City of Redmond.

Section 2. The City Council has determined that there is a need for senior citizen housing facilities within the City of Redmond, that the facility proposed by the King County Housing and Community Development Division will help to meet this need and therefore King County's application for 1982 block grant funds for the Senior Housing Program is appropriate.
