

RESOLUTION NO. 605

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND,
WASHINGTON, SETTING FORTH THE PROJECTS AND ALLOCATION OF
FUNDS FOR THE 1982 HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT
BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing at its regular meeting of October 20, 1981, and at the conclusion of said hearing having determined the projects and fund allocations for the 1982 Housing and Community Development Block Grant Program, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES that the projects and allocation of funds for the 1982 Housing and Community Development Block Grant Program shall be as follows:

1. Food bank funding will help establish a Redmond distribution center. \$5,000
2. Senior citizen transportation for part-time van driver 3,500
3. Youth Eastside Services will provide professional services for family and youth counseling. 23,000
4. Community services for personnel and supplies. 15,000
5. Emergency Housing - will provide temporary shelter, counseling, assist in securing long term housing and other needs for low income families. 5,725
6. Home improvements including consolidation of major and minor home repair, home security, sewer connections and LID assistance and smoke detector programs. 50,270.75
