

RESOLUTION NO. 610

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, APPROVING REVISIONS TO THE 1982 HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM TO ALLOCATE UNUSED FUNDS AND REFLECT A REDUCTION IN THE CITY'S ALLOCATION AND AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 605.

WHEREAS, the City Council passed Resolution No. 605 on December 1, 1981, establishing the City's 1982 Block Grant programs and allocations, and

WHEREAS, there is a need to revise the allocations to said programs to reflect a reduction in the funds allocated to the City pursuant to the Community Development and Block Grant Program and to reallocate unused funds, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Resolution No. 605, passed by the City Council on December 1, 1981, is hereby amended to reflect the following reallocations of funds:


- 1. Food bank funding - will help establish a Redmond distribution center. \$ 5,000.00
- 2. Senior citizen transportation - for part-time van driver. 3,500.00
- 3. Youth Eastside Services - will provide professional services for family and youth counseling. 23,000.00
- 4. Community services - for personnel and supplies. 15,000.00
- 5. Emergency Housing - will provide temporary shelter, counseling, assist in securing long term housing and other needs for low income families. 6,153.25
- 6. Home improvements - including consolidation of major and minor home repair, home security, sewer connections and LID assistance and smoke detector programs. 50,023.75
