Apport for Repeal of Sales Tax on Food

RESOLUTION NO. 615

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASH-INGTON, DECLARING THE SUPPORT OF THE ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE CITY OF REDMOND FOR THE REPEAL OF THE IMPOSITION OF THE STATE SALES TAX ON RETAIL SALES INVOLVING FOOD.
