

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON  
DEFINING FUNDING GUIDELINES FOR THE 1983 COMMUNITY  
DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the King County Housing and Community Development Division has required the City of Redmond to establish Block Grant Funding Guidelines. Therefore,

THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVE AND STATE THAT:

1. The City of Redmond will develop the 1983 Community Development Block Grant Program for projects within the City limits, following the framework of general funding guidelines. These guidelines respond to current economic conditions, Federal and State budgetary cutbacks that affect the City, and previous Block Grant accomplishments, and

2. Redmond will continue to emphasize the provision of safe and decent housing. Rehabilitation projects which alleviate health and safety hazards and projects which provide emergency shelter will be favored, and

3. Because there are no concentrated areas of low income families in Redmond, the City is unable to fund many eligible Block Grant activities. As a result, the City emphasizes programs which have a broad community base and are made available to all eligible City residents. Projects which provide direct service and positively impact the largest number of residents will be favored. Applicants must clearly show what target group they intend to serve and clearly document the need for the project, and

4. Because of the federal mandate restricting dollars for public service and planning programs, established programs will have priority over new applications, (assuming the established program successfully accomplished its program objectives.) New projects which do not fall into the public service or planning category are encouraged.
