RESOLUTION NO. 622

A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE BLOCK GRANT JOINT
APPLICATION SUBMITTED TO KING COUNTY BY THE
KING COUNTY HOUSING AUTHORITY.

WHEREAS, King County is an urban county applicant for Block Grant funds under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, and an urban county consortium has been established by interlocal agreement to which the City of Redmond is a party;

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond has adopted goals and policies relating to the use of Block Grant funds to insure safe and decent housing;

THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF REDMOND DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City of Redmond hereby supports the application to King County by the King County Housing Authority to provide temporary emergency housing for homeless families in East King County.
2. The Joint Policy Committee of the King County Block Grant Consortium shall be notified that the City of Redmond will support and co-sponsor this project.
