

RESOLUTION NO. 626

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE REDMOND WAY AND EAST LAKE SAMMAMISH PARKWAY NORTHEAST INTERSECTION TRAFFIC SIGNAL PROJECT 79-ST-09 TO SERVICE ELECTRIC COMPANY INC. AND RELEASING THE BID BOND OF UDL INC. DUE TO AN OBVIOUS ERROR IN THE BID.

WHEREAS, upon opening of the bids for the Redmond Way and East Lake Sammamish Parkway Northeast Intersection Traffic Signal Project 79-ST-09, it was determined that an error was made in the bid of UDL Inc. of Bellevue, Washington, which, pursuant to bid specifications, would allow the City to award the contract to such bidder only at the amount of \$149,558.30 rather than the bidder's purported bid of \$165,558.30, and

WHEREAS, such bidder refused to accept award of the contract on the lower amount, claiming obvious error in the bid, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that, due to error in the bid of UDL Inc., the contract should be awarded to the second lowest bidder, Service Electric Company Inc. of Woodinville, Washington, whose bid was in the amount of \$166,231.00, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The contract for the Redmond Way and East Lake Sammamish Parkway Notheast Intersection Traffic Signal Project 79-ST-09 be, and hereby is awarded to Service Electric Company Inc. of Woodinville, Washington.


Section 2. The bid bonds of all other bidders shall be released upon acceptance of the award by Service Electric Company Inc.
