RESOLUTION NO. 636

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, PROVIDING FOR THE CALLING OF A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMISSION TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY CERTAIN ISSUES TO BE ADVISORY TO THE CITY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond, Washington, has determined to submit to the qualified voters of the City a proposition as to whether or not general obligation bonds should be issued for the purpose of acquiring certain real property commonly known as the Redmond Golf Course, and

WHEREAS, there are certain other issues of community wide importance that the City Council is seeking an advisory ballot from the qualified electors of the City in order to provide the City with the opinion of the qualified voters of said city relating to said issues, and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond has already requested that a special election be held within the City for the purpose of issuing the general obligation bonds for the possible purchase of the golf course site and in connection with said election additional advisory ballot propositions should be submitted to the qualified voters of the City, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council finds that a need exists to place certain advisory ballot propositions on a special election to be held in the City on May 17, 1983.

Section 2. The Clerk of the City is directed to certify to the Director of Records and Elections of King County, Washington, at least 45 days prior to the May 17, 1983, special election date, a copy of this resolution and the propositions to
