

RESOLUTION NO. 637

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, SUPPORTING THE PROPOSAL BY THE NORTH/EAST KING COUNTY MULTI SERVICE CENTER FOR THE RESTORATION, RENOVATION AND MANAGEMENT OF THE ST. EDWARD FACILITY IN ST. EDWARD STATE PARK.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond has worked extensively with the North/East King County Multi Service Center over the years both in development of their facility and with funding and development of some of their programs; and

WHEREAS, the City, through its own studies and experience, recognizes the need for community facilities in this area of the State; and

WHEREAS, the City views development of the St. Edward facility as a unique opportunity to meet the critical needs of the area, and shares the general concern that lack of maintenance will lead to an irreparable loss of the physical structures; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Redmond supports in principle the attached proposal by the North/East King County Multi Service Center received February 14, 1983, regarding the restoration, renovation and management of the St. Edward facility.

Section 2. The City respectfully requests the Washington State Legislature to perform a detailed study of this proposal and provide serious consideration to its implementation.
