

RESOLUTION NO. 642

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 636 OF THE CITY PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON MARCH 31, 1983.

WHEREAS, the City Council passed Resolution No. 636 on March 31, 1983, requesting that an advisory ballot proposition be placed on the special election to be held May 17, 1983, and

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting of Tuesday, April 5, 1983, a member of the City Council voting on the prevailing side moved to reconsider said resolution, and the City Council having agreed to reconsider the same and upon reconsideration having determined that the matter should not be placed on a ballot, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Resolution No. 636 passed by the City Council on March 31, 1983, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby instructed to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Director of Records and Elections for King County and request that the advisory ballot proposition requested to be put on a special election for May 17, 1983, as authorized by Resolution No. 636, be removed from the ballot for said special election.
