

ORDINANCE NO. 65

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUORS, PROHIBITING THE SALE OF BEER WITHOUT A LICENSE, PROVIDING FOR LICENSING OF BEER DISPENSARIES, AND FIXING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to sell or to have in one's possession for the purpose of selling any intoxicating liquor or any beer or wines having an alcoholic content in excess of that which is now or hereafter may be fixed by Act of the Congress of the United States of America.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful to sell any beer containing any alcohol without a license issued by the town council as hereinafter provided.

Section 3. If, and when, the sale of beer and light wines shall be authorized by act of the Congress of the United States of America, not to exceed two licenses for the sale thereof may be granted by the town council of the Town of Redmond. Any such license shall be granted only after the receipt of a written application therefor, and after investigation of the qualifications, character and reputation of the person so applying. The granting or refusal of such application shall be purely in the discretion of the council and subject to the approval of the mayor. All licenses shall be revocable at any time without preliminary notice by action of the council and on the approval of the mayor. No such license shall be transferrable without the consent of the council and the approval of the mayor.

Section 4. Any such licenses shall be for the period of one year and the fee therefor shall be \$300.00, payable monthly in advance at the rate of \$25.00 per month. In the event of non-payment in advance the license shall be automatically cancelled without action of the council.

Section 5. All beer dispensaries licensed hereunder shall remain closed at all times between the hours of 11 P.M. and 5 A.M.

Section 6. Any person violating this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not exceeding \$100.00, and to imprisonment of not to exceed thirty days, or both.
