

RESOLUTION NO. 663

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 659 PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON OCTOBER 18, 1983, BY RE-SETTING THE DATE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING UPON A PETITION FOR VACATION OF CERTAIN PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON CITY FILE NO. RV-83-1.

WHEREAS, a petition for vacation of a right-of-way has been filed with the Office of the City Clerk, signed by the owners of more than two-thirds of the property abutting the right-of-way to be vacated which is located at the Northwest corner of the intersection of Northeast 40th Street and 172nd Avenue N.E., and

WHEREAS, the City Council determined that a public hearing should be held for the purpose of considering said petition for right-of-way and set the public hearing for November 15, 1983, and

WHEREAS, due to insufficient time for giving notice of said hearing the date of the hearing should be changed to December 6, 1983, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

A public hearing upon the petition for vacation of certain public right-of-way located at the Northwest corner of the intersection of Northeast 40th Street and 172nd Avenue N.E., in the City of Redmond, Washington, City File Number RV-83-1, shall be held in the City Council Chambers at the Redmond City Hall at 8:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, on December 6, 1983, which is not less than twenty-eight nor more than sixty days from the date of passage of this Resolution, at which time all persons interested in said right-of-way vacation are invited to appear and be heard. The City Clerk is directed to post, publish and mail notices of said hearing at least twenty days prior to the date set for hearing, pursuant to Community Development Guide Section 20F.20.070(15)(b).
