A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING A FEE SCHEDULE FOR USE OF CITY PARK AND RECREATION FACILITIES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The attached one page document, entitled "1984 Fees and Charges Schedule", identified as "Exhibit A" and hereby incorporated in full by this reference, is hereby adopted as the Fee Schedule for the use of City park and recreation facilities for the City of Redmond.

Section 2. The above referenced Fee Schedule shall be effective as of the date of adoption of this resolution and the Parks and Recreation Director is instructed to immediately implement said fee schedule.

FEEES AND CHARGES SCHEDULE

It is the policy of the Redmond Parks and Recreation Department to charge a fee for reserved use of its facilities. The fee partially offsets the administrative and operation costs associated with the facility. Additionally, the Redmond Parks Department believes that it is fair and reasonable to charge a greater fee to non-Redmond individuals and/or groups because they do not contribute through general taxes to the revenues of the City of Redmond. The Redmond Derby Days Celebration and any other City of Redmond sponsored activity shall be exempt from the fees and charges set forth below.
