RESOLUTION NO. 673

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, REJECTING THE LOW BID RECEIVED ON THE HARTMAN PARK PHASE IIA RESTROOM/MAINTENANCE BUILDING PROJECT AND AWARDING THE BID TO THE SECOND LOWEST BIDDER.

WHEREAS, bids for construction of the restroom/maintenance building in connection with Phase IIA of the Hartman Park improvements, Project 83-PK-20, were opened on April 10, 1984, and

WHEREAS, upon review of the bids it has been determined that the bid submitted by the low bidder, Ed Boulton Insulating and Glass, Inc. of Seattle, Washington, is defective due to the failure of the bidder to include within the scope of the bid additions to the proposed work set forth in an addendum to the bid documents, and

WHEREAS, upon the recommendation of the Director of the Public Works Department, the City Council has determined that the bid should be awarded to Horizons Unlimited of Seattle, Washington, the second lowest bidder, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The bid submitted by Ed Boulton Insulating and Glass, Inc. of Seattle, Washington, for construction of the restroom/maintenance building, Hartman Park Phase IIA, City Project 83-PK-20, is hereby rejected.

Section 2. The bid submitted by Horizons Unlimited of Seattle, Washington, for construction of the restroom/maintenance building in connection with said project in the amount of \$65,563.00 is hereby accepted and the Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract pursuant to said bid.
