

RESOLUTION NO. 682

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING
UPON A PETITION FOR VACATION OF CERTAIN
PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE CITY OF REDMOND
WASHINGTON, CITY FILE NO. RV-84-2.

WHEREAS, a petition for vacation of right-of-way has been filed with the Office of the City Clerk, signed by the owners of more than two thirds of the property abutting the right-of-way to be vacated, which is located at the end of 159th Avenue NE at the southern edge of the Tamarack Lane Subdivision, and,


WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a public hearing should be held for the purpose of considering said petition for right-of-way vacation, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

A public hearing upon the petition for vacation of certain public right-of-way located at the end of 159th Avenue N.E. at the southern edge of Tamarack Lane Subdivision, in the City of Redmond, Washington, City File No. RV-84-2, shall be held in City Council Chambers at the Redmond City Hall at 8:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, on September 18, 1984, which is not less than 28 nor more than 60 days from the date of passage of this resolution, at which time all persons interested in said right-of-way vacation are invited to appear and be heard. The City Clerk is directed to post, publish and mail notices of said hearing at least 20 days prior to the dates set for hearing, pursuant to Redmond Municipal Code section 20F.20.070(15)(b).
