RESOLUTION NO. 684

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, APPROVING AN INTER-LOCAL AGREEMENT WITH KING COUNTY PROVIDING FOR JOINT PREPARATION OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT FOR THE PROPOSED ANNEXATION OF THE REDMOND GOLF COURSE SITE.

WHEREAS, the unincorporated area north of State Route 920 and immediately south of the City of Redmond Central Business District, bounded on the west by the Sammamish River and Leary Way N.E., on the south by Bear Creek and State Route 920, on the east by a parcel known as the "Butler-Walls" property, and on the north by Burlington-Northern railroad tracks (hereafter referred to as the Redmond Golf Links site), is the subject of an application for annexation into Redmond, and

WHEREAS, this same parcel of unincorporated King County has been proposed for rezoning from S-E (Suburban Estates) to B-C (Community Business) for the purpose of allowing a regional shopping center (hereafter referred to as Redmond Town Center), and

WHEREAS, it has been proposed that King County and the City of Redmond agree to share the responsibilities of the lead agency as described in the SEPA Guidelines for the purposes of preparing an environmental impact statement (EIS) for the proposed Redmond Town Center Shopping Center, and

WHEREAS, King County and Redmond recognize the opportunity for efficiency in preparing an EIS that can adequately serve both jurisdictions' interests, now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
HEREBY RESOLVES:

That the agreement which has been prepared to provide for the joint preparation of an environmental impact statement by

the City of Redmond and King County concerning the City annexation and County rezone of the property generally known as the Redmond Golf Course site should be, and hereby is approved and authorization for the Mayor to execute the agreement which has previously been given by oral motion is hereby reaffirmed.
