A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, SHOWING SUPPORT OF THE PRE-HOLIDAY PROGRAM IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE YEAR OF THE DRUG FREE CHILD.

WHEREAS, Governor Spellman has proclaimed the 1984-1985 school year as YEAR OF THE DRUG FREE CHILD; and

WHEREAS, Redmond Senior High School and the Redmond High School PTSA Council are launching a program to involve the Redmond community in a comprehensive program to support the ideal of drug free children by sponsoring a Pre-Holiday Program, December 5, 1984 for parents of children and youth attending Redmond High School and its feeder Elementary and Jr. High schools; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Redmond endorses and applauds the community effort of sponsoring a Pre-Holiday Program on December 5, 1984 to increase public awareness of the problems and to develop programs to reduce the consequences of the abuse of alcohol and other drugs.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Redmond encourages the City of Redmond staff to provide such assistance as necessary to make the Pre-Holiday Program a success, and urges parents in Redmond to support the program with their presence at the December 5 program.
