RESOLUTION NO. 693

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 652 AND AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO APPOINT A HEARING OFFICER FOR HEARINGS PURSUANT TO RCW 69.50.505.

WHEREAS, the Redmond City Council finds that Resolution No. 652 appointing the Hearing Examiner to conduct hearings concerning drug related seizures and forfeitures under RCW 69.50.505 should be repealed because these hearings consume a significant amount of the Hearing Examiner's time and it would be more appropriate to permit the Hearing Examiner to devote his time to land use matters, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Resolution No. 652 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. The Chief of Police is authorized to appoint a hearing officer for drug related seizures and forfeitures under RCW 69.50.505. The hearing officer shall be an attorney qualified to practice law in the State of Washington with experience in criminal and constitutional law issues.
