

RESOLUTION NO. 696

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, REQUIRING A PUBLIC HEARING BEFORE CITY APPROVAL WILL BE GIVEN FOR THE EXTENSION OF 159th AVENUE N.E.

WHEREAS, residents in the vicinity of the present terminus of 159th Avenue N.E. have expressed their concerns over the future extension of this street and the possibility that it will be made a through street, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the concerns of surrounding residents should be considered in the context of any specific proposal to extend 159th Avenue N.E. or to make it a through street, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

City approval for any extension of 159th Avenue N.E. or any street improvement that would make 159th Avenue N.E. a through street shall not be given prior to conducting a public hearing before the City Council, Hearing Examiner, or other appropriate City body for the purpose of giving surrounding residents and all other interested parties the opportunity to express their concerns. Advance notice of such hearing shall be given to residents in the vicinity of 159th Avenue N.E.
