ORDINANCE NO.

An Ordinance regulating the keeping of Dogs, within the Town of Redmond.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Redmond

-1-LICENSE..

The keeping of dogs within the limits of the Town of Redmond is hereby forbidden unless the owners or keepers thereof shall procure a license for each dog, and the annual license is hereby fixed at the following rates:

On each Male Dog, \$11

On each Female Dog, \$2.

-2-

LICENSE, HOW-POSTING -TAG..

On payment to the Town Clerk of the amount of the license he shall issue to the person applying for the same one license which shall remain in full force for one year from the first day of January of each year, and not longer. The clerk shall furnish with each license a metal tag, giving the number of license so issued, and a description of the dog for which it is issued, and such tag shall be attached to a collar which the owner or keeper shall provide and place upon the dog so licensed.

DOGS WITHOUT LICENSES..

It shall be the duty of the Marshal to below all male or female dogs found running at large without having on a collar, with a licensed tag attached, showing the payment of the license for the current year. In the event the Marshal knows the owner of any such dog before colling the same he shall notify the owner to procure a license, but no liability shall all attach to the Marshall or Town of Redmond for the killing of any dog, found running at large, without a licensed tag, whether the owner of said dog be known to the Marshal or not.
