

ORDINANCE NO. 70

AN ORDINANCE fixing the salary of the Town Clerk,
and repealing all Ordinances in conflict therewith.

WHEREAS the Town of Redmond is now engaged in the replacement of its wooden water mains with cast iron mains, and during the course of this work the duties of the Town Clerk are heavily increased, most of the increased work resulting from this improvement to the Water System,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Redmond as follows:

Section 1. That until the work of replacing the existing wooden water mains by cast iron mains under the Federal and State Grant and Aid No. C-17-6 is completed, the salary of the Town Clerk shall be and hereby is increased, effective as of November 1, 1933, from the sum of \$15.00 to the sum of \$65.00 per month, of which \$15.00 is to be paid out of the General Fund and \$50.00 out of Special Water Fund No. C-17-6

Section 2. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
