RESOLUTION NO. 702

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, SUPPORTING A LIMITED OPEN HEART SURGERY PROGRAM AT OVERLAKE HOSPITAL MEDICAL CENTER.

WHEREAS, cardiovascular/heart disease is the leading cause of death, and one of the top causes of morbidity and health care expenditures, and

WHEREAS, Overlake Hospital Medical Center is the primary provider of services to Eastside residents afflicted with heart disease, as well as a primary recipient of heart attack victims benefiting from Medic I service, and

WHEREAS, limited open heart surgery and coronary angioplasty programs at Overlake will improve Eastside residents' access to clinically and cost effective, state of the art cardiac care services, and

WHEREAS, residents of the Eastside warrant access to these services comparable to that enjoyed by Seattle's residents, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Redmond City Council supports Overlake Hospital Medical Center and Providence Medical Center's efforts to establish a limited open heart program at Overlake.
